Spotlight of the month:

ELLEN WOOTEN COLQUITT
JUNE 4, 1908-FEB. 19, 1981

Long time resident of Boston, Mrs. Ellen Wooten Colquitt was a beloved member of Boston Baptist Church. She was a member of Miss Carrie Barrow's first Sunday School class, which planted the seeds of her great love for God's word. She married Roy Colquitt, an engineer by trade. As a young woman, she traveled with him throughout the state of Georgia building roads. She studied under Fennis Jennings Dake, a renowned Bible scholar in Lawrenceville, Ga., and furthered her love and knowledge of the Bible. Upon Roy's retirement, they returned to Boston and remodeled the house she was raised in. It wasn't long before she was teaching the adult Sunday School class; it was not uncommon to have between twenty and twenty-five members present every Sunday. She taught using the King James Bible that Dake published with his remarks and commentary. Some of us still have these Bibles. She dressed from an era long gone, but she always looked elegant in her dresses, hats, gloves, and purses all
